

Safety Fundamentals for Managers & Supervisors Workshop Overview

Specific Learning:

Topics include leadership, the guiding principles of safety management systems, legislated rights and responsibilities, how to research legislation, the WCB system and how Managers/Supervisors can have a direct impact on the organization's WCB premiums. Additional topics include risk and hazard analysis, assessment and control; inspection and investigation.

Reasoning:

Managers and Supervisors have more direct and immediate control over the workplace than any other group. Many organizations are oblivious of their Managers/Supervisors legal responsibilities within the workplace.

Goal:

This workshop will provide participants with the required information to help them meet their legislated duties in the workplace. This workshop also shows due diligence on the behalf of the company by ensuring that Managers and Supervisors are trained to understand their responsibilities regarding Occupational Health and Safety in the workplace.

Duration and Materials:

The workshop is a full day workshop consisting of theory and group discussions. Participants will receive a manual which includes excerpts of the applicable legislation and industry best practices.
